My works are time and site sensitive, they insert disruptions in predominant narrations. My method is often research oriented, situating a select group or topic to intervene in a process with to dismantle social or geopolitical contingencies. It does not explore objectivity as a philosophical reson, but is based in responsiveness on personal and collective testimonies and set in context to other pre-negotiated narratives to create new discursive contexts. In this essence I see art as a site for elasticity, for critical dialogues, for doubt, for attempts for reestablishing a sense of direction or rhythm to disengage with conformity. I see my practice as a critical tool to reveal covert layers in society and explore the dimension of art as a reflective ground for consciousness of shared space, and resource, from a vantage point committed to society a public entity.

BIO

Hallberg works from a project-based method with a multidisciplinary structure and often converge the roll of the artist and the curator. The notion of in-betweenness, both in private life and geopolitically are often put in focus. The works include thorough research and are presented in art installations with fluid and multiple ways of interpretation. Photography, video, sound and text are used for installations or interventions. She is socially and politically engaged often the duration of work stretch over several years commitment. Central is her approach of everyday life and the rendering of collective memory and social justice topics.

Hallberg is a graduate from Stockholm Film School. She also holds a B.A in Curatorial and Cinema Studies from Stockholm University, Sweden (2003) and an M.Sc in International Museum Studies, University of Gothenburg (2008). Hallberg was the co-founder of Fotografins Hus in Stockholm (2003) and the Residency Program at Skövde Art Museum (2014). She has held numerous presentations at institutions such as Moderna Museet in Stockholm, School of Photography in Moscow, Srishti Institute of Art, Design and Technology in Bangalore, University of California at Berkeley and Santa Cruz as well as at One Archive/ University of Southern California in Los Angeles. She has exhibited in Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Austria, Mexico, the US and Sweden. In recent years she has led a number of socially engaged art projects, often focusing public space. She was the co founder of Fotografins Hus in Stockholm in 2003 and in 2014 the Residency Program at Skövde Art Museum focusing on Socially Engaged Art where she has since 2014 has an ongoing role as curator of development and strategy. Between 1999-2003 She was based in San Francisco and New York working with documentary filmmakers Mia Engberg and Barbara Hammer in addition to being the Sr Creative Producer at a PR and rebranding firm, RDAi, working for fashion and technology accounts. Prior to moving back to Sweden she worked on the curatorial team for Exit Art in New York.

"Resonance som består av två videoprojektioner presenterade på två fritt hängande dukar. När man står där känner man "ja, så här är det". De två verken består bara av några fotografier och två videoprojektioner. Måste de verkligen låta så mycket? Gitte Villesens danska blir nästan obegriplig. Utställningen visar två slags förhållningssätt. Den politiskt korrekta konsten är en attityd som knappast är främmande för någon samtida konstbesökare. Den karakteriseras av det statliga regleringsbrevets byråkratiska sexighet fyllt av dolda eller öppna förmaningar som i sina bästa stunder ljuder av mångfald och öppenhet men vars baksida lyder förnumstig rättnings i ledet." " Det som likväl slår mig när jag tar del av installationen Resonance (2005–06) är ensamheten och utsattheten hos de medverkande. Utställningen i Norrköping är en kärleksförklaring till denna fruktbara strategi."
